<u>WHAT:</u> The Barnett Reservoir Foundation and the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District's 2nd Annual Independence Day Celebration

LOCATION: Old Trace Park, located in Ridgeland

WHEN: Saturday, June 29, 2013

ACTIVITIES:

<u>2:00 PM</u>: Kicking off with Water Fest, hosted by MDEQ and REZonate there will be live music, children's activities, food vendors and educational exhibits. The Independence Day Celebration will include the above plus military displays including flyovers.

DUSK AROUND 8:30 PM: A lighted boat parade will begin

<u>FIREWORKS</u>: Set from a barge in the reservoir making a beautiful display over the big water. Music will accompany the fireworks by radio station, MS 103.

<u>PARKING:</u> Parking will be available at Madison Landing and surrounding fields and lots, but no event parking is allowed at local restaurants. This event is free and also includes activities at Lakeshore Park in Rankin County. "

Introducing Architectural Committee Chair.....Annette Vise

Congratulations, Graduate!

Annette Fortman Vise, a 25-year Breakers resident, graduated with honors from the Else School of Management at Millsaps College. Vise completed a Masters of Business Administration (MBA), with an emphasis in finance. She holds an undergraduate degree, a Bachelor of Science in Architecture, from Mississippi State University.

Vise accepted her diploma at the Millsaps commencement ceremony on May 11, 2013. She proudly wore the cords of two honor societies, Financial Management Association, and Beta Gamma Sigma, the most prestigious business honor society in the nation. Inclusion in the FMA National Honor Society requires a concentration of course work in finance and a minimum GPA of 3.5 for graduate students. Invitation to Beta Gamma Sigma is limited to the top 10% of graduate business students. Vise was tapped into the FMA National Honorary Society on October 17, 2012 and into Beta Gamma Sigma on April 2nd of this year.

Vise divides her career between design work, consulting, and teaching. She has been involved in design projects large and small, from the post-Katrina rebuilding of the Pass Christian Municipal Complex to designing

modest 1,000 square-foot Habitat for Humanity homes. In 2012 she penned, with two architect colleagues, the master plan for Hattiesburg's Twin Forks Rising District, for which the team received an ovation when the plan was presented to the Hattiesburg City Council.

In 2005, in the wake of Hurricane Katrina, Vise led an effort by the Mississippi Chapter of the American Institute of Architects to provide free building assessments to all home owners who requested one. 1,500 damage assessments were performed, free of charge, for Mississippi Gulf Coast home owners affected by Katrina. Vise was subsequently recognized by the AIA for her exemplary service in the wake of the storm.

As adjunct faculty at the Mississippi State University College of Art and Architecture, Vise has taught Professional Practice to fifth-year architecture students for five years in the MSU satellite design studio in Jackson. She has juried scores of fifth-year student thesis projects. Of all her professional endeavors, Vise enjoys teaching best. She equates it to mothering, with less cooking.

Vise has made her home on the Breakers Lane since 1988. She can often be spotted tending her pots and the strip of garden adjacent to unit 27. She has recently lent her eye for design to the flower bed at the Breakers entrance gate, applying the same concepts of color, structure, and scale which she applies to designing buildings to the few square feet of dirt at the entry. "Design is design, whether it's a building, a garden, or an outfit. The same concepts apply" says Vise. Vise has two college-age daughters, Rachel and Mailande, and a pair of spoiled felines.
